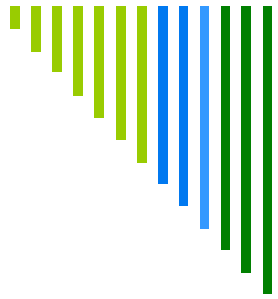

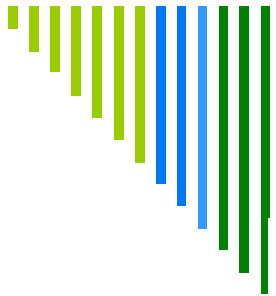

(1980)**

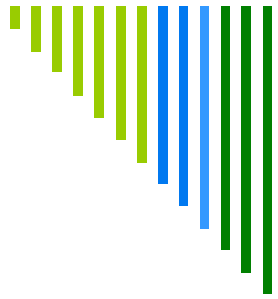

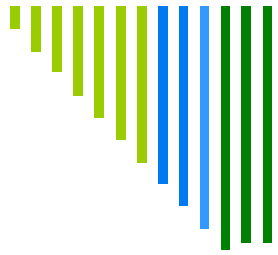
