Our funded programs are currently offered to 100% of Charlotte-Mecklenburg elementary, middle and high schools.

PROGRAMS for ARTS in EDUCATION

- **Curriculum Connections** **\$210,000**
Links the arts to other academic subjects such as language arts, social studies, and math
24 GRANTS
- **Education In the Arts** **\$165,000**
Develops understanding and skills in music, dance, theatre and visual arts
19 GRANTS
- **Learning Events** **\$270,000**
Offers large audience, multi-class performances that reach a broad segment of students
5 GRANTS
- **ArtStart** **\$105,000**
Two and one half-day workshop for CMS 4th grade classroom and arts teachers to guide the development and implementation of arts-integrated lessons aimed at helping students excel in writing; artist residencies
- **Professional Development Workshops** **\$21,000**
Strengthens teacher and artist skills in arts integration, assessment, documentation of student learning and grant writing
